

World Café Breakout Session

Through history, conversation has been a primary process for making sense of our world, discovering what we value, sharing knowledge and imaging our future.¹ The World Café is methodology for creating a network of conversations around questions that matter. At the IWGBDS workshop, all participants will join in a World Café dialogue in the afternoon of Day 1. The goal of the session is to capture the thoughts and ideas of each participant on a series of 6 topics/questions.

Proposed questions:

- 1. What do I value most about data sharing / what possibilities do I hope will be part of its future?
- 2. Regarding biological data sharing, what surprises have you found? What challenges? What's exciting?
- 3. What types of biological data sharing among the 4 quadrants are working well in your opinion? Why? What enables this?
- 4. What types of biological data sharing among the 4 quadrants are not working well in your opinion? Why? What are the barriers?
- 5. What's missing from the biological data sharing conversation? What topics have we missed?
- 6. If you could instantaneously have one thing happen, be created, or realized to solve your biological data sharing needs, what would it be? Why?

Logistics:

- 6 café table stations will be set up, each equipped with paper table covering, markers, a copy of 1 of the 7 questions, a moderator, and a notetaker.
- 1 question will be discussed at each café table station.
- There will be 6 rounds of 15 minutes of discussion time for each question.
- Participants will rotate through the café table stations on a preassigned rotation (on nametag).
- 3 minutes will be given between rounds for participants to move to the next table assignment in their rotation
- Discussion points/ideas captured on paper will be built upon be successive groups.
- Each station will have a moderator and a notetaker to provide guidance and continuity.
- The moderator and notetaker will collaborate to summarize the highlights of the discussion at their table in a World Café wrapup session.
